Certificate of Entry (COE) application and required documents

1. Declaration Form
2. A copy of 15-night ASQ booking and payment (paid in full), 14-day quarantine (date of arrival counts as day 0)
3. Medical and travel insurance with a minimum of 100,000 USD Coverage, including but not limited to COVID-19 treatment throughout the stay in Thailand
4. A confirmed flight ticket

Note: Tourist Visa (TR) holder is permitted to stay in Thailand for 60 days and can apply for a 30-day extension of his/her visa at the Immigration Bureau with 1,900 THB fee.

Non-Immigrant 'B' visa (Business Visit/Single Entry) and COE Procedure

Certificate of Entry (COE) application and required documents

1. Declaration Form
2. A copy of 15-night ASQ booking and payment (paid in full), 14-day quarantine (date of arrival counts as day 0)
3. Medical and travel insurance with a minimum of 100,000 USD Coverage, including but not limited to COVID-19 treatment throughout the stay in Thailand
4. A confirmed flight ticket

1. Fit-to-Fly medical certificate
2. A COVID-19 free medical certificate (RT-PCR-test)
(issued within 72 hours before departure)



Non-Immigrant 'B' visa application and required documents

1. Passport with more than 6 months validity
2. Visa application form
3. An invitation letter from a Thai company with a registered capital not less than 2 million THB or evidence showing ownership of a condominium/deposit in a Thai bank/ Thai government bond with face value not less than 3 million THB
4. 6-month Bank Statement with funds not less than 500,000 THB or equivalent
5. Other documents required by the Embassy/Consulate (case by case basis)

2. A copy of 15-night ASQ booking and payment (paid in full), 14-day quarantine (date of arrival counts as day 0)
3. Medical and travel insurance with a minimum of 100,000 USD Coverage, including but not limited to COVID-19 treatment throughout the stay in Thailand
4. A confirmed flight ticket

1. Fit-to-Fly medical certificate
2. A COVID-19 free medical certificate (RT-PCR-test)
(issued within 72 hours before departure)



Non-Immigrant 'O-A' visa application and required documents

1. Age of 50 years old or over
2. Passport with more than 18 months validity
3. Visa application form
4. Bank Statement with funds not less than 800,000 THB **or** a certificate showing monthly income not less than 65,000 THB **or** accumulated money of deposit and monthly income not less than 800,000 THB for a period of 12 months
5. Criminal record clearance from the country of nationality or country of residence
6. Medical certificate stating that the applicant does not have any prohibited diseases according to the Ministerial Regulation No. 14 (B.E.2535)
7. Health and accident insurance coverage that covers the period of stay in Thailand, with a minimum of 40,000 THB coverage for outpatient treatment and 400,000 THB coverage for inpatient hospital and physical services.

Non-Immigrant 'O-X' visa (Multiple Entry) and COE Application Procedure

1. Declaration Form
2. A copy of 15-night ASQ booking and payment (paid in full), 14-day quarantine (date of arrival counts as day 0)
3. Medical and travel insurance with a minimum of 100,000 USD Coverage, including but not limited to COVID-19 treatment throughout the stay in Thailand
4. A confirmed flight ticket

1. Fit-to-Fly medical certificate
2. A COVID-19 free medical certificate (RT-PCR-test)

(issued within 72 hours before departure)



Non-Immigrant 'O-X' visa application and required documents

1. Age of 50 years old or over
2. Passport with minimum 6 months validity
3. Visa application form
4. Bank Statement showing money deposited in Thai bank located in Thailand with the amount of not less than 3 million THB **or** a certificate of bank deposit in Thai bank located in Thailand with the amount of not less than 1.8 million THB and have income with the amount of not less than 1.2 million THB per year. Once the applicant enters Thailand, he/she must have accumulated money deposited in Thai bank located in Thailand not less than 3 million THB with 1 year. The money must be kept in bank account at least 1 year before withdrawing and the money must be left in the account with the amount of not less than 1.5 million THB.
5. Criminal record clearance from the country of nationality or country of residence
6. Medical certificate stating that the applicant doesn't have any prohibited diseases according to the Ministerial Regulation No. 14 (B.E.2535)
7. Health and accident insurance coverage sold by **Thai insurers** that covers the period of stay in Thailand, with a minimum of 40,000 THB coverage for outpatient treatment and 400,000 THB coverage for inpatient hospital and physical services.

Note: (1) A non-immigrant 'O-X' visa holder is permitted to stay in Thailand for 5 years and can apply for a 5-year extension of his/her visa at the Immigration Bureau.
(2) Eligible nationalities: Australian, Canadian, Danish, the Netherlands, Finnish, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Norwegian, Swedish, Swiss, UK, and US.

Special Tourist Visa (STV) and COE Application Procedure

Certificate of Entry (COE) Application and required documents

1. Declaration Form
2. A copy of 15-night ASQ booking and payment (paid in full), 14-day quarantine (date of arrival counts as day 0)
3. Medical and travel insurance with a minimum of 100,000 USD Coverage, including but not limited to COVID-19 treatment throughout the stay in Thailand
4. A confirmed flight ticket.

Collecting COE and passport with STV and prepare the following documents before departure :

1. A Fit-to-Fly medical certificate
2. A COVID-19 free medical certificate (RT-PCR-test)
(Issued within 72 hours before departure)



Special Tourist Visa (STV) application and required documents

1. Passport with more than 12 months validity
2. Visa application form
3. Documents and payment in regard to accommodation (after 14 days in ASQ)
 - (1) In case of staying at Hotel(s) or renting Apartment / Condominium / House
 - A copy of hotel booking (or renting contract) and payment (paid in full until the departure date)
 - 6-month Bank Statement with funds not less than 500,000 THB or equivalent
 - (2) In case of owning a condominium in Thailand or hire-purchasing a condominium, needs to provide evidence showing ownership or evidence of hire-purchase contract in Thailand with at least two installments paid.
4. Health and accident insurance coverage sold by **Thai insurers** that covers the period of stay in Thailand, with a minimum of 40,000 THB coverage for outpatient treatment and minimum of 400,000 THB coverage for inpatient hospital and physical services.

Documents for checking-in at the Airport before departure and when arriving in Thailand

1. COE
2. Fit-to-Fly medical certificate
3. Covid-19 free medical certificate (RT-PCR-test)
(Issued within 72 hours before departure)
4. Medical and travel insurance with a minimum of 100,000 USD Coverage, including but not limited to COVID-19 treatment throughout the stay in Thailand

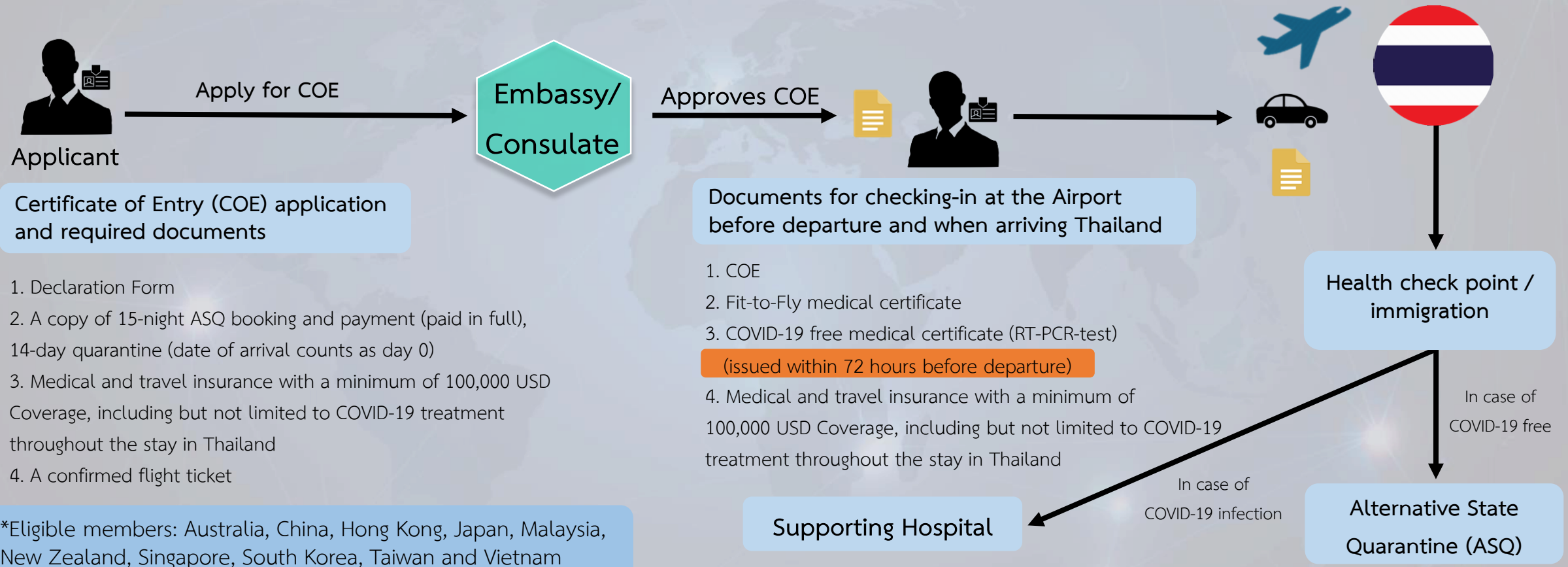
